Part of our care plan is to offer Emergency appointments. These will be held during our normal working hours:

Monday-	09:00 – 17:00	Tuesday -	09:00 – 17:00
Wednesday-	09:00 – 18:00	Thursday-	09:00 – 17:30
Friday-	09:00 – 18:00	Saturday-	Closed <i>(Pre-booked Endodontic treatments only)</i>

We charge **£55** for an emergency assessment, with a dentist who will exam the area of concern, come to a diagnosis and discuss treatment options.

We charge **£225** for an emergency pain relief appointment, with a dentist who will exam in area of concern, come to a diagnosis and discuss treatment options. Includes pain-relieving treatment e.g. Temporary fillings/simple extraction/1st stage Root Canal Treatment/ dry socket dressing etc.

All patients registered and unregistered are welcome.

In case a permanent solution is preferred and suitable, our standard price list fees apply instead on top of the Emergency assessment fee (£55)

If the practice is closed and/or the dentist is unavailable:

Emergency appointment charge:

Appointment Fee *(between 9am – 8pm)* – **£75**

Appointment Fee *(between 8pm & 10pm)* – **£150**

Appointment Fee *(between 10pm & 12am)* – **£350**

Appointment Fee *(between 12am & 9am)* – **£500**

- Uncontrollable dental bleeding following an extraction
- Rapidly increasing swelling around the throat or eyes
- Injuries to the face caused by trauma
